2. . INAUGURATION OF FREE TAILORING UNDER PM-USHA SCHEME

Under the PM-USHA Scheme, KTS Govt Degree College has initiated a 15-day free tailoring coaching programme for women students of the college as well as other women in the town. The programme is sponsored by SKP Govt Degree College, Guntakal.

During the inauguration, the Principal, **Dr. Sreenivaslulu**, emphasised the importance of skill development in the personal and professional lives of young people. He highlighted that acquiring practical skills such as tailoring can open up avenues for self-employment and financial independence.

The Women Empowerment Cell Convener, **Smt. Fareesha**, urged the students to attend the sessions regularly and make the most of the opportunity to learn valuable skills from the trainer.

The trainer, **Ms. Vaani**, appreciated the enthusiastic response from the girl students who came forward to participate in the programme. She expressed confidence that the tailoring skills gained during the training would help them achieve self-employment and become self-reliant in their lives.



3. ADMISSOIN CAMPAIGN

As part of the admissions campaign for the academic year 2026–27, the college staff approached nearby junior colleges and addressed the students. They explained the academic facilities, infrastructure, skill development programmes, and support services available in the college, and invited the students to visit the campus at any time for further information and guidance.

Dr. A. S. Vijaykumar, Lecturer in Botany; Dr. Narayana, Lecturer in Telugu; Dr. Lakshminarayana, Lecturer in Commerce; and Dr. Prasad, Lecturer in Physics, visited the junior colleges and encouraged the students to choose the best institution for their higher education, highlighting the quality education and opportunities provided by the college.



4. HEALTH HYGINE & MENTAL WELNESS

The Health, Hygiene, and Mental Wellness Awareness Program was effectively addressed by the resource person, Dr. Mansoor Ali. In his keynote address, he emphasized that health is the overall well-being of both the mind and body, and that physical health and mental wellness are deeply interconnected. Dr. Mansoor Ali highlighted the importance of maintaining healthy personal habits such as regular walking, physical exercise, and the consumption of nutritious food. He stressed that these habits play a vital role in preventing lifestyle-related diseases and improving overall quality of life. The resource person drew attention to a major health concern among women, stating that nearly 50 percent of women suffer from anemia, which is caused by a deficiency of blood or hemoglobin. He explained that blood is essential for carrying oxygen throughout the body and that low blood levels often result in problems such as tiredness, weakness, and reduced immunity. Special emphasis was given to female students, as women generally experience blood loss during their monthly menstrual cycle and therefore require adequate iron intake. Students were advised to include iron-rich foods in their daily diet, such as green leafy vegetables, fruits like apple and sapota, and natural sources like jaggery. He also encouraged the consumption of home-based nutritious food and adequate intake of water to maintain good health. Regarding menstrual hygiene,

Dr. Mansoor Ali stressed the importance of proper care among female students. He advised them to change sanitary pads every six hours, maintain personal cleanliness, and follow hygienic practices to prevent infections and related health issues. He further highlighted the importance of maintaining cleanliness and hygiene in daily life. As part of skin healthcare, he provided useful tips and recommended the use of sunscreen to protect the skin from harmful effects. The session also focused significantly on mental wellness. The resource person explained that stress is very common in today's academic and social environment, but managing stress is essential for a healthy life. He emphasized that students should not handle stress alone and should have trusted people to talk to, such as friends and family members. He highlighted that having more social connections reduces stress, and that sharing thoughts and feelings openly plays a crucial role in managing mental pressure and maintaining emotional balance. The program was highly informative and created awareness among students about adopting healthy lifestyles, maintaining hygiene, and managing mental wellness effectively. The session encouraged students to take responsibility for their physical and mental health, leading to a healthier and more balanced life.



5. SWARNA ANDHRA & SWACHHA ANDHRA

As part of the Swarna Andhra – Swachh Andhra Program, a Zero Gap Sanitation Program was successfully conducted on 23rd Feb 2026 at KTS Government Degree College, Rayadurg.
